

# Brusaporto cycle and pedestrian path

Motorway to Lovere, junction for Bagnatica, Brusaporto

This non-demanding route, which is also suitable for wheelchair users, winds along the foot of the Brusaporto hill and skirts gently sloping hills among fields and vineyards. The starting point is the car park near the Brusaporto Municipal Sports Centre.



We walk along via Belvedere and on the left we find a second car park.



We cross a small crossroads and continue along via Belvedere.



We turn left into via Beder and then left again into via degli Aceri.



We reach a signpost informing us that we are on the Cammino Vescovado (Bishop's Way), which is marked by signpost.



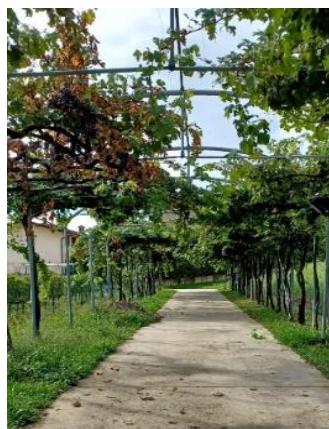
Continuing towards the Tomenone hill, we turn left at the fork onto the cycle path.



Along the way, we cross Via Cantalupa, taking care.



Continuing on, we encounter a signpost for the cycle path.



In the final part we pass under an arbour of strawberry grapes ('Oselina').



We decide to take the same route as the outward journey for the return and encounter another information sign that we had not noticed on the outward journey.



After the intersection with via Cantalupa, we choose to take an alternative route and turn right at the fork. We walk along via Vigna and turn left into via Torrazze.

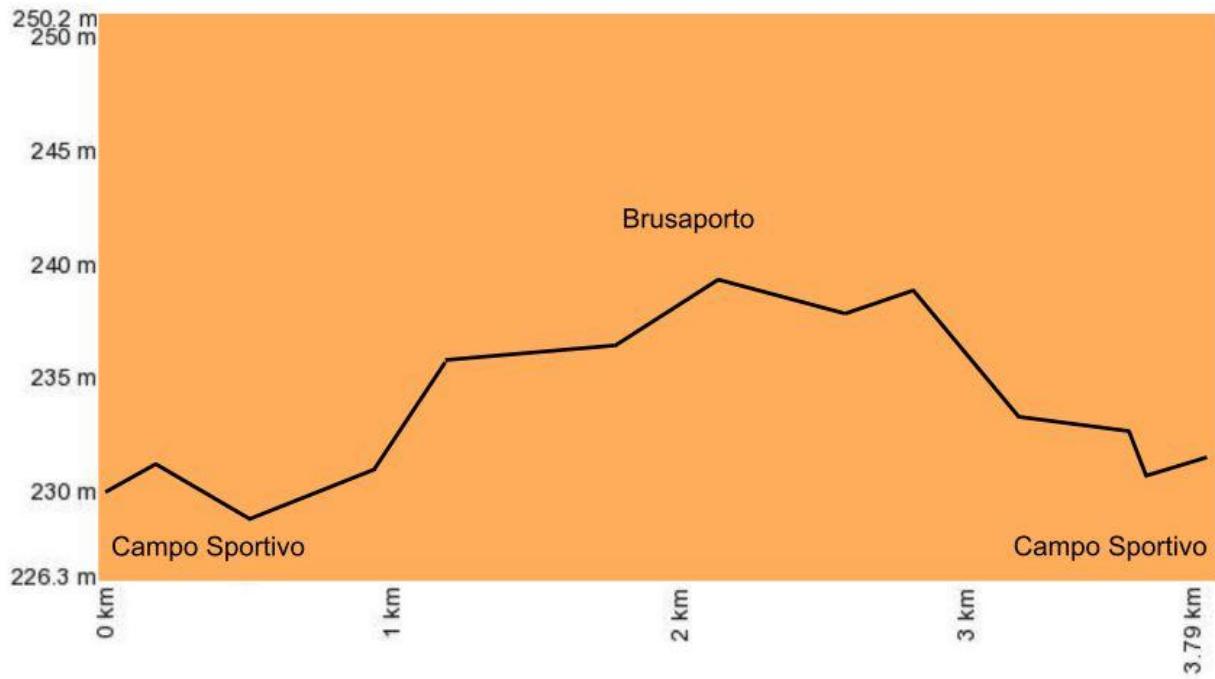


We reach the side entrance of the Sports Centre.
