We begin our walk after parking at the sports field.



We reach the Adda river, with boats moored near the shore.



We continue our walk until we reach Piazza Carlo Frigerio with its tower.




The walk is quick, given the very little traffic, and we continue following the course of the Adda.



Ahead, we see the Brivio bridge over the Adda, to the right towards Como, to the left towards Bergamo.




We now reach the Vecchia Filanda of Brivio.



In the distance, we can see the houses of the first hamlet we will reach.



We have arrived at the hamlet of Molinazzo di Brivio.



The River Adda reaches a bend and the water appears to be still, but this is only an illusion.




We reach the hamlet of Toffo di Brivio, with our cars frozen solid.



Continuing on, we pass a barrier and on our right we reach the Toffo water treatment plant.



We have arrived at the small bridge where our excursion will end.




On the left, on the opposite bank, after the island, is the Alberone Oasis.
