

# From Calusco d'Adda to the Chiesetta dei Verghi chapel

We begin our walk after parking the car in Via Monastero dei Verghi in Calusco d'Adda.



We turn left, cross Via Vittorio Emanuele II, and turn right into Via Marsala, which is unpaved.



We reach a barrier, which we pass, turn left and continue along the Leonardesco path.



The path is wide and compact and slopes steeply downhill.



In the distance, we can see the Ponte di San Michele bridge ahead of us.





Passing underneath it, we admire this example of road engineering.



Turning right, we reach the end of our descent and continue on a dirt road.



Now the path is easier and we can admire the greenery around us.



On our left, we pass vertical signs informing us of the various routes available.





Now the path narrows, becoming a typical hillside trail in the woods.



We reach and climb a few small hills, on compact ground, which makes walking easier.



To our right, we struggle to make out a fork in the path, leading to a secondary trail.



The rather uneven side path leads to a small beach on the River Adda.





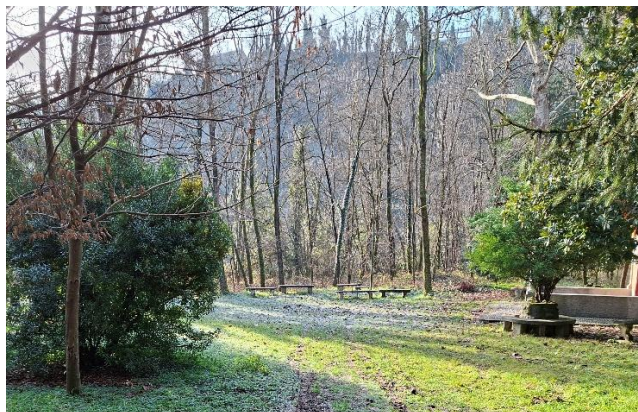
After deciding to return to the starting point, we reach a fork and turn left.



The path takes us to a picnic area equipped with benches and tables.



We are about to reach the Chiesetta dei Verghi (Church of the Verghi)..



Continuing our exploration, we admire the open space in front of the church.





Turning left, we glimpse a path that leads us towards the River Adda.



At the bottom of the descent, we see the old Paderno dam.

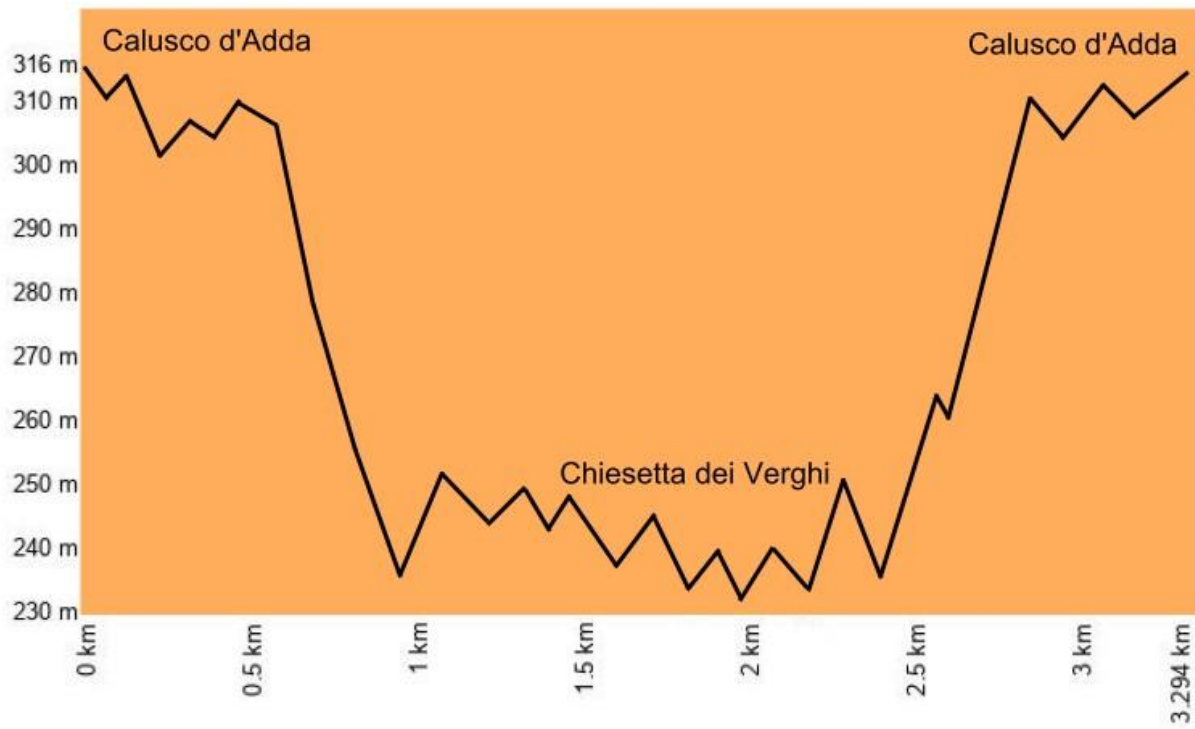


We turn our gaze 180° and reach the Chiesetta dei Verghi.
