

From Azzone to Prato Grande and the Alpine Chapel

We park in the clearing on the left side of Provincial Road 60, between Azzone and the hamlet of Pradella, 26, and set off along the path on the right (trail marker CAI 429), we are on Via Decia.



As we climb, we pass some small steps designed to channel rainwater.



When we reach the fork, we continue straight ahead along the rural road.



We pass a partially renovated barn ("Teie") on our left.



The path enters the woods and the terrain changes, but the walk is brisk.



We reach a second barn ("Teie"), also on the left, which is very well maintained.



At the fork we come to, we continue straight ahead through the beautiful woods.



Ahead of us, we see the owner of the small barn ("Teie") on the right, who is cutting wood.



As we emerge from the woods, we are greeted by the green of the meadow and the buildings we see on the hilltop.



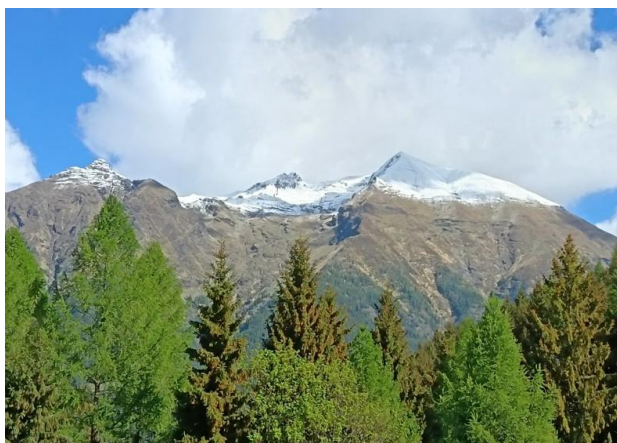
On the left is a picnic area with benches, tables, and a shelter, all made entirely of wood.



On the right, we can see the little Alpine Chapel and walk over to it.

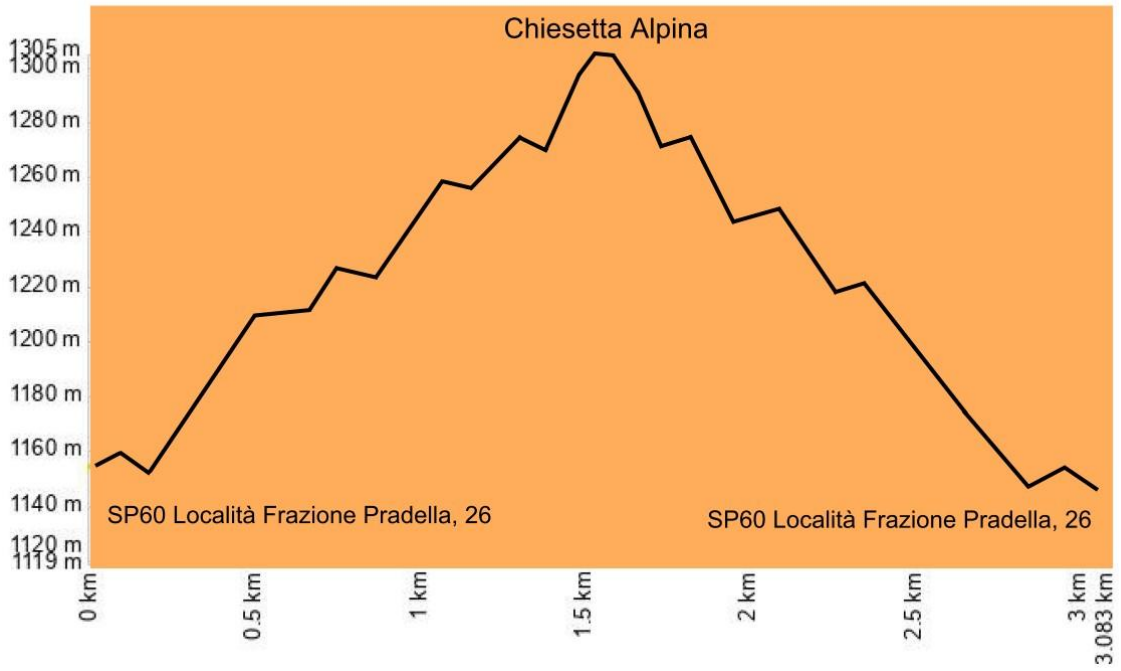


After a moment of reflection, we turn around and can admire the Pizzo Camino massif.
